The eye of the e, the ear, link and loop of the g (marked in red) are unique terms to those specific characters and not used elsewhere The following terms are sometimes used to describe the same element: Bowl/Lobe \cdot Finial/Terminal \cdot Apex/Vertex \cdot Stroke/Diagonal Stem Aperture vs. Counter an aperture denotes the opening to a mostly enclosed space in a character, a counter is a fully enclosed space in a character Shoulder us. Hook a shoulder leads into a stem, a hook leads into a terminal or beak
