

HOW TO INSTALL YOUR FONT
You will receive your files as a zipped folder.
For instructions on how to unzip your folder, visit LauraWorthingtonType.com/faqs/.
Your font is available in two formats: TrueType Font file (.ttf) and OpenType Font file (.otf).
If you have a Mac® ${ }^{\circledR}$ or newer Windows ${ }^{\circledR}$ computer, install the .otf file(s). If you have an older Windows computer, install the .ttf files. Install the font by double-clicking on the .ttf or .otf file. When the popup menu appears, click on Install font (Mac) or Install (Windows). Fonts may also be installed by dragging and dropping them into your system's font folder.
After installing your font, save a copy of the downloaded font files in a folder on your computer as a resource in case you want to re-install the font or transfer it to a new computer.

## HOW TO INSERT SWASHES,

ALTERNATES, AND ORNAMENTS
Some programs have a glyphs or symbol panel where the complete font including swashes and ornaments can be accessed and inserted directly. For programs that do not have a way to directly insert the swashes, the easiest method of putting in alternate swashes or symbols is by using either Character Map (Windows) or FontBook (Mac).

## Character Map (Windows)

Character Map is a standard Windows utility and can be found in the Start Menu's accessories folder (Windows XP, Vista, 7) or in All Apps under Windows Accessories (Windows 8.1, 1O). Character Map can also be found by searching for it by name.

Select your font from the drop-down menu. Character Map will show all available glyphs. To quickly find the swashes, change Group By to Unicode Subrange, and select Private Use Characters from the pop-up menu. Click on any swash and then copy and paste it into your document.

## FontBook (Mac)

Font Book is a standard Mac utility program and can be found in Finder under the Go menu under Applications. Once FontBook is open, go to the View menu and select Repertoire. Click on User in the left panel and then select the font name to see all available swashes in the font. Click on any swash and then copy and paste it into your document.

Otl Fresco is made even more versatile when titling is actwated in the Epen Tlype palettl), served along with swash forms, contextual alternates, and oinaments to sweeten this tasty typeface.

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OAs with my other type designs, ©Al Fresco doesn't live in isolation, but wokes a special ambience, era, or lifestylein this case, an enviably carefice, chic, and organically trendsetting life, authentic and true to oneself and simply delicious. Maturally, each designer who uses my woik fitters it through their unique interpretation, imbuing the fonts with a wonderful array of results such as thosefound on menus, food packaging, branding for light colognes, or young, hip, clothing boutiques. ©fl Fresco was boin in my imagination as an emblem of dining ontside at twilight under twinkling lights, langhing waimly with friends, sipping signature cocktails and eating tapas-cach bite cripping with

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intenseflavor. In the workday setting. Ftl Friesco repiesents a style that is pretly but not diessy: swishy bright flowery skirts and cute little flats. "Business casual", not cubicle prisoner Atfter all, FAl Fiesco comes fiom the 18 the century Stalian "in the fresh air"

For those who arefamiliai with my Atummingbird typeface, All Fresco has a more loose and uniestrained feel. Icreated it using faster strokes, and was unconceined with convention. Affer the complexity of my Charcuteriefamily of typefaces, I longed for simplicity. I retwined to simple tools: little felt biush pens with fixed tips, fun to use for practicing

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lettering. To loosen up after howis of intense design, I wanted to play with forms and tools that were refieshing and clean Starting with the word "Siresistible" I began filling pages with letters and words. Ohhile I usually stait with lowercase letters, my initial focus with Ftl Frescos shape began with strong uppercase letters that set the tone for what I then realized would be my next typeface. Dhile lowercase letters are used more fiequently, making © Al Frescós uppercase letters the focal point added an opportunity for variety and an unconventionality- it cant really be attributed to any one style. That, in twin, colored the lowercase letters, allowing some "fiesh
air" into the design. Each word in a typespecimen is distinctly different from the words alongside it. Each is a little bit unexpected.

Atl Fresco makes ample nse of Epen Typefeatures. If you actevate tilling, the loops have been removed from the lowercase ascenders and descenders, giving the typeface a cleancer aesthetic and more contemporary feel. This feature provides you with fonts that are almost a style within a style. 157 lowercase swash forms, 46 ligatures lmost of which are purely decorative rather theanfunctional), and 16 oinaments are the cherry on top-or in the case of Gtl Fresco, the marinated Spanish olive in your maitini.

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Ots often discovered in my work, there are always more treasures in the package. In this case, two addelitional sets of uppercase letters are inclucled. Dhen contextual alteinates are activated, youll find that ending strokes have been minimized. (Software often twins these on by defanlt.) This addlitional feature offers a more natural look, adding a slight trandomness or quirkiness a aspecial touch that reveals the waim th and uniqueness of the human hand and mind s
